








"Booker Nation - Bradenton/Sarasota LINKS NSBE JR. Chapter"

STEM is a part of every aspect of our lives! Call to Action

- African Americans are under-represented in STEM fields at every degree level relative to our percentage in the U.S. college-age population.
- The number of African Americans receiving engineering degrees is declining, largely due to fewer African-American women earning degrees in the field.
- There will be 1.4 million more software development jobs than applicants who can fill them; other STEM fields also have significant shortfalls in applicants prepared to fill them.
- We MUST fill the pipeline with African American students who can help shape *our* future. Exposing our youth to STEM helps them see themselves as scientists and engineers.
